SPECIAL TOWN BOARD MEETING **APRIL 26, 2017** **MINUTES**

A Special meeting of the Wheatland Town Board was called to order by Chairman Tegen at 6:00 pm on Wednesday April 26, 2017 at McMichael St in the Town of Wheatland.

The Meeting was properly posted at the Community Center, the Redmound Store, the Recycling Center and the Town Website.

Row call was taken by Supervisor Ballwahn; Chairman Phil Tegen-present, Supervisor Jayne Ballwahn-present and Supervisor Don Stokke Jr-present

Chairman Tegen declared a Quorum was present

This was an informational meeting regarding the condition of McMichael Street.

Dave Fredrickson Supervisor for the Vernon County Highway Department was also present and discussed what the county will be doing along the bank of McMichael Street East of State Highway 35. They will be cleaning up the bank and putting erosion matts all the way up the hill and cleaning the tube/culvert under highway 35. After discussing the location for hauling the debris from this site, it was decided it would be best not to have the debris taken to the Wheatland yard area. Dave further indicated the county was hiring someone to clean the culverts under highway 35 at the bottom of Stevens Road, if the Town wanted to hire the same person for any cleaning of other culverts that the Town is responsible for, they can also hire him. He will get the name to us.

Some of the residents who lived on McMichael Street were present during the discussion. Chairman Tegen provided them information on a meeting which is to be held at the community center on May 2, 2017 at 6:30 pm which would discuss available funds to property owners to do restoration to their property from the storm damage. This information is also available on the Towns website

The meeting adjourned at 6:33 pm.
