### REGULAR MEETING **November 15<sup>th</sup>, 2018** **MINUTES**

The regular meeting of the Wheatland Town Board was called to order Chairman Tegen, with the Pledge of Allegiance. The Meeting was properly posted at the Community Center, the Redmound Store, the Recycling Center and the Town Website.

Motion by Ballwahn/second by Stokke to, “approve the October 15<sup>th</sup>, 2018 regular meeting minutes as presented.” Motion carried.

Public comments: None

Motion by Stokke/second by Ballwahn to, “accept the 2019 proposed Town Budget approve the 2019 Tax Levy as presented by the Town Electors”, motioned carried.

Supervisor Ballwahn indicated Town Attorney will start to review claim from Gregory A. Stedman and Secura Insurance in regards to the damage on Lawrence Ridge Rd.

There was no update on the ownership of Battle Ave. Sergeant Olson will review all information received on Pennel Rd ownership and will contact Supervisor Ballwahn to discuss.

There have been no applications for the part-time patrolman position.

Patrolman McCumber reported they hauled rock out of Genoa and dumped on Stevens Rd. Installed plows on trucks, sanded roads, will need steel for snow wheels, used 96-Peppy to haul sand from Lansing and ordered new batteries for the trucks.

No Fire Department report.

Financial reports were presented and reviewed by the Town Board. All accounts are reconciled and balanced. October income is \$26,860.41 and Expenses are \$47,408.61. Total cash on hand, in all funds, is \$249,624.53.

Motion by Tegen/second by Ballwahn to, “transfer \$67,000 from Kerndt Brothers Lansing MM to Peoples Bank checking account.” Motion carried.
