REGULAR MEETING **July 18th, 2019** **MINUTES**

The regular meeting of the Wheatland Town Board was called to order Chairman Ballwahn, with the Pledge of Allegiance. The Meeting was properly posted at the Community Center, the Redmound Store, the Recycling Center and the Town Website.

Present: Chairman Jayne Ballwahn, Supervisor Gloria Binger, Supervisor Doug Trussoni, and Clerk Joann Schultz. Treasurer Kelly Boardman was absent.

Motion by Ballwahn/second by Binger to, “approve the June 20th, 2019 regular meeting minutes as presented.” Motion carried.

Public comments: Nick and Mark Wang came with questions in regards to Geesa Rd.

Motion by Ballwahn/second by Trussoni to, “classify both Lawrence Ridge Road and E. Missel Rd to class B roads.” motioned carried.

Chairman Ballwahn provided a copy of the Road Alteration Application form.

Chairman Ballwahn reported for Patrolman McCumber: Lawrence Ridge Rd and East Missel Rd are ready for seal coat. Scott will be there the end of the month. Patrolmen finished mowing the roadsides and continue to patch roads and clean ditches. Replaced release valve on 140G grader.

Clerk Schultz read the Fire Department report: 2 Fire Calls, 5 WEMS Calls, 4 training stipinds and 1 meeting. The Fire Department picnic date changed from August 10th to August 11th noon at Blackhawk Park (Shelter 2).

Motion by Ballwahn/second by Trussoni to, “approve building permit for Timothy Ruenger at S6891 Brown Rd for a garage/workshop.” motioned carried.

Financial reports were presented and reviewed by the Town Board. All accounts are reconciled and balanced. Total cash on hand, in all funds as of this date are \$238,387.17.

Motion by Ballwahn/second by Binger to, “accept financial reports as presented.” motioned carried.

Motion by Ballwahn/second by Trussoni to, “approve checks #23170- #23207 and EFTPS & WT6 ACH's.” motioned carried.

Clerk Schultz indicated that the Town received notification from Attorney Peterson of the Order for Dismissal signed by Judge Rood on May 20, 2019 related to the case of the Town of Wheatland vs. Gregory A. Stedmand and Secura Insurance Case No. 2018-CV-135.

Motion by Ballwahn/second by Trussoni to, “transfer \$25,000 from People's MM to People's Checking account.” Motion carried.

Motion by Ballwahn /second by Trussoni to, “adjourn the meeting.” motion carried.
