Dump Site Operational Guidelines

Dump Site:

The Town of Wheatland Municipal dump site is located in a general storage area located behind the Town Shop in Red Mound, WI. The work site is secured with a locked gate, but no fenced enclosure.

General:

The Town accepts refuse exclusively from Town of Wheatland Residents and Non-residential Town of Wheatland Property Owners. The Town has no commercial accommodations. Residents must bring refuse to the site and place refuse in appropriate dumpster, rubble site, or indoor storage facility.

Pick-up Service:

1. The Town of Wheatland has no scheduled residential refuse pick-up service.
2. Residential/Commercial refuse pick-up service is available from Area Private Contractors.

Hours of Operation:

1. Saturday morning from 8:00 AM to 1:00 PM, Holiday, Friday before.
2. Wednesday afternoon from 1:00 to 5:00 PM, Holiday, Tuesday before.
3. Other disposal times may be accommodated by contacting the Town Chairman and/or Town Patrolman, for dump access.

Custodian Authority:

1. The Dump Custodian has complete oversight in identifying residents, accepting normal refuse, encouraging segregated recycling and/or rejecting refuse, and collecting fees, during open hours.
2. Fees must be paid for by check only, made out to the "Town of Wheatland".
3. There are no receipts and/or cash available on site.

Conflicts and/or Violations:

1. Conflicts with the custodian may result in loss of immediate access to this service.
2. Serious conflicts may result in potential denial of this service and/or legal action.
3. The Wheatland Town Board has final jurisdiction of any and all issues.

Collection Dumpsters:

1. One Recycling Dumpster, labeled with segregated compartments, furnished by Vernon County Land Fill.
 - a. Individual plastic milk jugs and other plastic beverage containers only.
 - i. No grocery bags or miscellaneous plastic items.
 - b. Cardboard boxes must be flattened to conserve space.
2. Three General Refuse Dumpsters, furnished by Contracted Service, emptied twice each week.
 - a. Not suitable for large bulky items (see rubble sites below).

Rubble Sites, within the General Dump Site: (Rubble to be handled and/or disposed of by Town Personnel)

1. A rubble site to collect metal and/or majority metal items, including appliances. See fee below, for any refrigerated appliance.
 - a. The refrigerant should be left intact.
 - b. Doors must be removed from refrigerators and freezers.
 - c. LP Cylinders must have valve removed.
2. A rubble site to collect tire casings.
3. A rubble site to collect used furniture, mattresses and minor scrap lumber.
4. A rubble site to collect Ag Plastic (silage bags) Tarps and other large Plastic Items.
5. A rubble site to collect brush, yard and garden wastes.

Inside Storage: (storage provided for subsequent delivery to Vernon County Land Fill)

1. Inside storage drums for waste oil disposal and filters.
2. Inside storage for parcel paint cans, liquid must be treated with an absorbent, like kitty litter or floor dry, to dehydrate the liquid into a solid form.
3. Inside storage for Fluorescent bulbs and ballasts, see fee below.

4. Inside storage for TV's and all electronic devices, see fee below

Fee Items: (Checks only, no cash or receipts available on site)

1. Tire casings from residents only, no commercial disposition.
 - a. Car tire - \$3.00 each
 - b. Truck or Tractor tire - \$5.00 each
 - c. Tractor Tires over 24" - \$10.00 each
2. Refrigerators, freezers, air conditioners, de-humidifiers - \$10.00 each, doors must be removed.
3. TV and any other Electronic Devices - \$10.00 each.
4. Fluorescent bulbs and/or ballasts - \$1.00 each

Prohibitions/ Prohibited items: The following refuse issues are prohibited

1. No Commercial refuse accepted.
2. No disposing of refuse outside the dump site gates after hours.
3. No refuse disposal when closed, even if the gate is open. See Hours of Operation above.
4. No prescription drugs, pesticides, weed killers, poison or other chemicals.
5. No asbestos containing material.
6. No large amounts of building materials.
7. No rummaging and/or removing any refuse from the dump site by unauthorized persons.

Freewill Donations: Donations may be accepted on an interim basis

1. Donated items restricted to aluminum cans and metal items.
2. No TV's, fee items or other prohibited items.
